**ARTICLE IV.**

The general officers of said corporation shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer and the Board of Directors shall consist of five stock holders.

**ARTICLE V.**

The principal duties of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors, and to have a general supervision of the affairs of the corporation.

The principal duties of the Vice-President shall be to discharge the duties of the President in the event of the absence or disability for any cause whatever of the latter.

The principal duties of the Secretary shall be to countersign all deeds, leases and conveyances executed by the corporation, affix the seal of the corporation thereto, and to such other papers as shall be required or directed to be sealed and to keep a record of the proceedings of the Board of Directors and to safely and systematically keep all books, papers, records and documents belonging to the corporation or in any wise pertaining to the business thereof.



ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

THE NEW YORK RECORDING LABORATORIES

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ARTICLE I.

The undersigned, all of them adults and residents of the state of Wisconsin, have associated and do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter 86 of the Wisconsin Statutes; the business and purpose of which corporation shall be the manufacture and selling of phonograph records, phonographs, phonograph parts and the manufacture and sale of all things incident to the use in connection with the same, which said business is to be carried on within the state of Wisconsin, and especially within the county of Ozaukee, in said state.

ARTICLE II.

The name of said corporation shall be THE NEW YORK RECORDING LABORATORIES and its location shall be in the city of Port Washington, county of Ozaukee and state of Wisconsin.

ARTICLE III.

The capital stock of said corporation shall be TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) and same shall consist of one hundred (100) shares each of which said shares shall be of the face or par value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00)

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
